VIOLENCE
– **manifestations and possible ways of prevention**

We invite you to participate in the work of this scientific conference.

According to the Definition of the World Health Organization, by violence we mean any intentional use of physical force or power against oneself, another person or against a group or community, resulting in or is very likely to result in injury, death, psychological injury, developmental impairment, and the like. Therefore, violence can occur in various forms - such as physical violence, verbal or psychological (emotional) violence. Depending on who it is directed to, we divide violence into self-governing, interpersonal and collective violence. The first form involves suicidal thoughts or self-harm of an individual. Interpersonal violence is the most common form of violence, manifested as a form of abuse committed against a child, peer, young person, spouse, elderly person, etc. *Mobbing* or *harassment* is a form of repeated physical or psychological violence (torture, injury) committed by a group towards an individual. Cyberbullying is especially important considering the fact that we live in an age of flourishing and the availability of digital technologies. Violence that contains elements of sexual abuse is a particularly serious form of violence. The most notorious form of collective violence is war. We are witnessing that the number of wars in the modern age is increasing significantly. Violence can occur within the family, in the workplace, in a school or other institution, in a public environment and the like. There is a difference between domestic and institutional violence. Often, the frequency of violence determines the economic development of a particular country, as well as the level of

education of the population. However, these are not the only factors influencing the incidence of violence in society. This has yet to be explored. As you can see, there are numerous forms of violence, which according to different criteria can be classified into different groups. Common to all forms of violence is that it negatively affects the personal integrity and development of the individual, as well as society as a whole. Violence is a factor that interferes with the normal growth and development of children, if children reside in a violent environment, and on the other hand contributes to the violation of the general public health and well-being of all victims. That is why public administration bodies, as well as numerous other private entities, are interested in preventing violence in all its manifestations, as well as providing assistance to victims in their recovery. Violence prevention ranges from raising awareness of society members to taking concrete, repressive measures. The task of the conference participants is to clarify the phenomenon of violence in theoretical terms, to examine the factors that affect the increase in the rate of violence in a particular country or world, as well as to examine the possible and most effective ways of preventing violence. Also, participants in the gathering should consider possible ways to mitigate the consequences of violence that has already occurred.

With this in mind, we invite you to participate in the XII International Scientific Conference with your scientific or professional work and contribute to the clarification of this issue.

Workload – up to 15 Pages A4

Title of the paper - Uppercase (Times New Roman 14 Bold)

Subtitles - Lowercase (Times New Roman 12 Bold)

Text – with line spacing 1 (Times New Roman 12), in one of the official languages used in Bosnia and Herzegovina or in one of the foreign languages of the world.

Footnotes – Times New Roman 10

A summary that must be read with keywords, which should also be translated into English. If the article was written by several authors and deals with different institutions, it is necessary to indicate in the note which of the above institutions each of the mentioned authors represents (it is possible to list several institutions). It is possible to be a maximum of three co-authors of one article, and each (co)author can participate with only one written work.

Bibliography – cited literature includes bibliographic sources, such as articles, monographs and the like, and is given exclusively in a separate part of the article in the form of a list of references.
